Evacuation Checklist

IMMEDIATE evacuation

- Bring Grab and Go Bag; including prescription medications, important papers, list of contacts
- □ Bring pets and pet supplies if possible. Do NOT turn animals loose.
- Ensure to bring wallet with photo ID and payment methods
- □ Check on neighbours and assist, if possible, if they need help evacuating.
- □ Leave a note on your door saying that you have evacuated

MORE THAN ONE HOUR before evacuation

- \Box Be prepared with your emergency plan
- □ Have a minimum half tank of gas
- □ Prepare transportation if you do not drive
- $\hfill\square$ Park vehicles pointing away from house
- \Box Close up/lock up/leave outside lights on
- \square Pack kennel, water, medications, leash, collar, ID Tag, food & treats, muzzle for pets
- $\hfill\square$ Pack camping gear if available
- \square Clear 10 metres of space around structures, including vegetation and flammable materials
- $\hfill\square$ Turn propane tanks off and move propane barbecue away from structures
- $\hfill\square$ Move flammable furniture to the centre of room
- $\hfill\square$ Turn off any running water, including automatic sprinklers
- Determine alternative place to stay, if possible, such as at a hotel or with family/friends out of Town
- \square Use your phone to video or photograph belongings, including inside closets and drawers



EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT CRESTON prepare. plan. stay informed. **ONE HOUR** before evacuation

- Pack your emergency kit including food & water, medication, toiletries, clothing, and comfort items
- $\hfill\square$ Close windows, doors, interior air/heat vents
- Pack additional clothing
- □ Pack your irreplaceable items like photos
