**Approval of this work plan does not guarantee approval of a rebate.** A complete rebate application and follow up are required once the mitigation work is complete.

**Rebates are awarded on a first come first served basis while funds are available.**

Once the work plan has been completed, residents may carry out work from the work plan and apply for a rebate ***once per year***. Rebates only apply to work that has been completed ***in the same year*** of the rebate application. A new home assessment is required every four years.

Only recommended work completed within 30m of the home is eligible for a rebate.
